Montfort School, Abhayapuri, was established in the year 2005 by 'The Institute of the Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel', a registered Religious Society totally engaged in the field of education.

The Society was founded in France, in 1700 by St. Louis Marie Grignion de Montfort, to teach and take care of the children in Charitable Schools. He was born on 31st January 1673, in a hamlet called "Montfort" in western France. He was a visionary and deeply convinced of the incredible impact education can play in forming a better world. Being a friend of the youth and the less privileged of his society he deliberately dedicated his entire life for their well being.

In his ardent desire to keep his vision alive and continue the mission, he realized the need to gather young men who can work ceaselessly for God and for man. Thus, the society of The Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel was founded by him to continue his educational works.

The Brothers continue to carry out the same mission by keeping his vision always alive and totally relevant to the times. He tirelessly worked for a cause with a vision and a mission to be fulfilled, and as a result he died at the young age of 43 on 28th April 1716. As recognition of the remarkable and generous service he rendered for God and for his fellow being, he was canonized as a Saint in the Catholic Church by His Holiness Pope Leo X on 7th July 1947. We, the Montfort Brothers, who deliberately choose and dedicate our lives pledge our support to keep that vision alive and relevant. Presently, we work in more than 34 countries in the world especially in the field of Education.

CBSE AFFILIATION

We are happy to share that we are affiliated to CENTRAL BOARD OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (CBSE), and our School is named as Montfort School Bongaigaon, by the CBSE and our affiliation number is 230135. We have become the first school to receive the CBSE affiliation from Abhayapuri.

Montfort School imparts holistic education aiming at the all round development of each and every child entrusted to its care, so as to turn out, not only good and useful citizens, but men and women of high principles, culture and refinement.

We provide ample opportunities to the students to bring out their best through various activities, competitions, celebrations, assemblies and special coaching.

The Students are divided into three Houses and healthy competitions are conducted throughout the year to bring out the best in them. Sports, games, art and culture are given importance in the school

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- * The ligua -frangua in the school campus is English compulsorily.
- * Pupils will keep the class rooms and school premises absolutely clean, thus promoting clean environment.
- * Damage to school property, disfiguring of walls, indecent language or such behavior are serious offences which are punishable.
- * Pupils will at all times show respect and reverence to school authorities and members of the staff
- * Pupils should be responsible for the safety of their belongings. They are advised not to bring any costly articles like mobiles, ornaments etc.
- * Only English should be spoken in school premises to acquire greater fluency in the use of the language.
- * Collection of funds or giving gifts to anyone for any purpose must be with the permission of the principal.
- * Pupils should not bring any magazine, periodicals or CDs or any Electronics goods to the school without the permission of the Principal.

- * Students are expected to take part in all the co-curricular activities of the school as part of the civic, cultural training.
- * Though every care is taken to ensure the safety and welfare of the students accidents are possible. The school is not responsible for accidents small or serious that happens to the students during the school hours.
- * The school is keen that the children maintaining a presentable personality in dress and outlook. Every pupil is expected to keep up the high tone of the school excelling in conduct and good manners in and out of the school.
- * For any reason, if students want to leave the school campus, it will be only with the Parents in person or with a duly authorized person only.
- * Submission of duly filled and signed gate pass at the school gate and entry at the gate register is a must for students to be taken out during the school hours.

DISMISSAL

- * Irregular attendance, non payment of fees, habitual disobedience and indiscipline, which is injurious to the moral, lead to the dismissal of a student at any time of the year.
- * Malpractice in examination is a great offence. If found guilty the following rule shall apply: for the first time the student shall be awarded zero marks for the subject in that particular examination. If repeated the student will be detained in the same class or dismissed from the school.
- * Any misbehavior of a serious nature that has become public knowledge either inside or outside the compound is liable to bring about suspension/dismissal from the school.

WITHDRAWAL

Children are admitted on the understanding that they would remain in the school at least for the entire academic year. In case a student wants to discontinue midway, the student has to pay the full annual fee to get the Transfer Certificate (TC) from the school.

- * An application for the transfer certificate should be made in writing by the parent or local quardian.
- * The management reserves the right to compel the parents to withdraw their children, if their conduct is harmful.

SYLLABUS

The school is following the examination process of CBSE from the academic year 2014-15. The syllabus and evaluation will be followed as prescribed by the CBSE. At present Montfort Abhayapuri offers education from LKG to Class-X.

VALUE EDUCATION AND HUMAN RIGHTS EDUCATION

Along with the Normal subjects, the curriculum in the school gives sufficient importance on Value Education and Human Rights Education.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Along with the academic teachings, the children are helped to develop their leadership qualities and talents in our children, by various clubs like Montfort Child Right Movements (MCRM), Eco Club, Music Club, Science Club etc. The school gives sufficient importance to sports, games and cultural activities to bring out the best in our students. We celebrate important events and days of the year and festivals to inculcate respect for everyone and to develop their patriotic spirit.



ASSEMBLIES

Well planned 'General Assemblies' and 'Particular Assemblies', give ample opportunities to the students to develop their leadership qualities and also to develop their various talents.

MONTFORT SCHOOL BUSES

The school bus services provided by the school administration is in view of the need of the student community of the locality. There are a few basic rules and formalities to be followed by the Parents and Guardians who would like to take admission for the school buses.

The routes, bus numbers and the fees will be fixed by the school authorities and those who are agreeing to this in the application form only need to take admission. Parents/Guardians are requested to carefully go through the rules and regulations for the school bus services and give their consent in writing before taking admission for the school buses. Those students who do not clear the fees more two months will not be allowed to travel the buses. Students need to carry the bus passes daily.

AUDIO VISUAL FACILITIES

The school, in its effort to cope up with the modern educational system, has Audio- Visual classrooms(Smart Classes). This media helped study goes in a very big way to make our children more effective and in par with their peers even in urban areas. We have acquired smart classes units in almost all our class rooms. Our staff is periodically trained to operate audio visuals systems.

FACULTY

The staff of the school is chosen after proper interview and model classes. Our staff members are put into intensive training by CBSE and periodical seminars by various agencies to keep themselves abreast with the changing times.

FACILITIES

Here at Montfort School Bongaigaon, we keep updating ourselves for administration and for excellence in academic and co-curricular activities. The following facilities are added to the school.

- * Audio-Visual classrooms are provided to all the students.
- Proper Public Addressing System to the classrooms and in the school helps in better communications
- * Well setup school ground for football, volleyball, basketball and badminton.
- * Modern water filtering system is installed to give safe drinking water.
- * Well equipped and furnished library with sufficient number of books on different subjects for the use of children.
- Well equipped Science Lab. & Computer lab.
- * For greater efficiency of the administration we have installed School Management Software.
- * Seminars are conducted for high school students
- * CCTV to ensure safety and discipline.

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE & CHILD RIGHTS COMMITTEE

The school has constituted Internal Complaints Committee which will examine all matters relating to women in the school and will make suggestions and proposals regarding such matters. The Child Rights Committee deals with rights of children and also looks after discipline.














ST. LOUIS MARIE GRIGNION DE MONTFORT
